Classes / Make-Ups

The Dance and Music Centre follows the Fairfield School System Calendar (exceptions are noted in the Dance and Music Centre calendar). All make up classes must be taken prior to May 1st and must be taken in the same level class or lower. Our are very active faculty choreographers, performers, & teachers and may be called away due to their artistic pursuits. The Dance and Music Centre will substitute with equally talented professionals. There must be a minimum of five students in attendance for a class to be held (10 for performance classes). Dance and Music Centre reserves the right to cancel or combine classes due to insufficient registration.

No credits or refunds are applied for missed classes, snow days, or holidays. Make ups are available for missed classes at the same or lower level. If a dancer drops a class prior to November 1st, the prorated balance (less the registration fee and a \$25 cancellation fee) will be held as a credit on the account to be used within one year. There is no refund or credit for classes dropped after Nov. 1st. Music lessons require 30 days notice for cancellation. Absences must be called in before scheduled class. Two makeups allowed per season.
