In Memoriam Glenn Paul Tietjen



Glenn passed away on April 8th 2021, due to complications of a lifeextending surgery. Glenn was originally from Long Island, New York where he was a professional musician from the age of 16 to 27. Glenn moved to southern California in search of warmer weather and that is where he met his wife of 42 years Janice. With their two year old

daughter in tow, they moved to south Natomas in 1985.

He worked for various organizations, but decided he would prefer to be self-employed, so in 1989 he developed the Crystal Clear Professional Window Cleaners, which he ran for 23 years.

After rediscovering his passion for music, Glenn decided to change careers and open the Natomas School of Music, in 2006. At that time, he was the only instructor. As enrollment increased Glenn hired additional teachers.

2020 was a rough year for small businesses, but through Glenn's perseverence, he manage to keep the school going. Glenn was not one to give up, and felt that he owed it to the community to remain in operation.

In 2021, the Natomas School of Music celebrated its 15-year anniversary, and is proud to announce that it has more than 350 students enrolled. Glenn understood the importance of bringing music instruction to the community. Thank you Glenn for your vision, as it has assisted so many students young and old, in achieving their goal in learning music!

The King of Ragtime Scott Joplin

Scott Joplin born in 1868, became well known for his ragtime compositions and dubbed the "King of Ragtime". He wrote more than 100 original ragtime pieces, a ragtime ballet and two operas. Growing up in a musical family, he developed his own musical knowledge with the help of local teachers.

In 1894, he moved to Sedalia, where he earned his living as a

piano teacher. He started publishing music in 1895, and his publication of "Maple Leaf Rag" in 1899 brought him instant fame. It has been said the Joplin's music had helped to revolutionize American music and culture by removing Victorian restraint.

Joplin told a friend once that he would not be a pop hero in his own lifetime "When I'm dead twenty-five years, people are going to recognize me". Joplin died in 1917, from complications of syphilis. As he predicted, in 1974 Joplin's music was adapted by composer Marvin Hamlisch for the movie "The Sting", winning an Academy Award for Best Original Song "The Entertainer". The whole nation took notice, but not of Marvin's score, as he was neither the writer nor arranger, but of Scott Joplin. In 1976 Joplin was awarded a special Pulitzer Prize for his contributions to American Music. Visit YouTube to hear some of his compositions as they are a delight to listen to!
