






Student Spotlight Mason

Composer of the Month Clara Josephine Schumann



Clara Schumann was considered one of the most distinguished composers and pianists during the Romantic era. She was married to Robert Schumann, also a composer. She began taking piano instruction at the age of 4. She made her debut in 1828 at the age of 9,



She toured for sixty-one years beginning at the age of eleven. She was considered a child prodigy and composed solo piano pieces, a piano concerto, chamber music, and choral pieces


